





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
Organizing Teacher Support through Coaching



Kenya Pilot Program (2011-2014)

- Tusome was designed following the successful implementation of the Primary Math and Reading (PRIMR) pilot program
 - USAID and DFID funded
 - Piloted in 1384 schools
 - Class 1 and 2
 - English, Kiswahili, mother tongue and math
 - Books, training and coaching
 - Compared several treatment groups
 - Successful models selected for Tusome

Kenya Pilot Impact



Goals of Tusome

Overall Goal: Improve literacy learning outcomes

Specific Objectives:

- To improve teacher capacity for effective delivery of the curriculum
- To enhance access to appropriate textbooks and supplementary materials
- To enhance instructional supervision and support to teachers by Curriculum Support Officers and Head Teachers

Tusome Instructional Support System: Good Coaching

Coaching Model design

- Focus is on coaching and not inspection
- Termly training for CSO
- Termly training for teachers by CSO
- Monthly zonal meetings
- Regular classroom observations



Classroom Lesson Observations

Classroom observations

- Focused on instruction
- Lesson observation-30 minutes
- 3 pupil assessments
- 10-15 minutes debrief
- Observation data uploaded from tablets
- 20,000+ visits per month





Value added by the coaching approach

- 1. Kenya is using existing personnel for coaching
- 2. Used medium scale pilot to test coaching model
- 3. Tablet-based instructional support system
- 4. Improved learning outcomes
- Global Partnership for Education's Primary Education Development (PRIEDE) program implemented alongside Tusome
